The History of Allhallows, Bedford





The car park is an in-situ, flat slab reinforced concrete construction made up of 7 split-level suspended reinforced concrete decks with inclined ramps allowing circulation from one deck to another. Circular in-situ reinforced concrete columns support the decks.

External access ramps are also reinforced concrete.


Allhallows was constructed in two distinct periods: The first part (East) – including the main stair core – was constructed in 1960; the second part of the structure (West) was built c. 1962. Both parts of the structure are separated by a 25mm movement joint.

The structure is approximately 94m long by 32m wide with 600 parking spaces. The main access stairs & lifts are at the front of the car park facing on to the bus station. Access stairs are also located at the two rear corners of the building. The car park is built over the top of Retail Premises.

Dedicated Disabled Lift & Parking



New disabled parking area created on 1st floor (at top of a perpendicular ramp which is now used solely for disabled vehicles only. The area was chosen as it was a "dead" area in relation to traffic flow. Previous provision was on levels 2 and 4 next to the main stair core.





 A new dedicated disabled lift was created on the ground floor which travels up specifically to the first floor only and is solely dedicated to Disabled users. For additional security the lift is locked at night and protected with roller shutters.
