Digitalisation & Data WG

Co-chairs: **Wilfried Thierry**, Indigo Group & **Nigel Williams**, Parking Matters Ltd.

- Increases awareness among EPA members of the strategic importance of parking data and data sharing, including the role of National Access Points (NAPs) at European and national level
- Develops a European Regulated Parking Data Profile and guidelines for the application of GDPR to parking
- Develops [practical tools](#) to help members achieve legal compliance
- Promotes [APDS](#) as the industry standard for parking data incl. in connected sectors (EV charging, secure cycle parking, Automated Valet Parking) with the relevant stakeholders (EVRF, CIE, EAVP, 5GAA,...), etc.
- Fosters AI applications in parking (e.g. Automated Valet Parking)
- Liaises with the EU-funded NAPCORE project on parking data sharing

Electromobility WG

Chair: **Peter Dingemans**, VEXPAN

- Develops and updates the [EPA Fire Safety Advice Toolbox](#) (with support from engineering consultancy ARUP)
- Provides expert input to the EU Commission Sustainable Transport Forum (STF) expert group
- Exchanges information and best practice among EPA members on all electromobility related issues
- Addresses parking-related electromobility challenges, including the deployment of charging infrastructure (cf. EU-level targets as per the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive, EPBD, Art. 14), grid capacity constraints, evolving business models, and the regulatory implications of EU legislation (incl. AFIR)

EPA's Activities

Our working groups (part 2)

Enforcement Working Group

Co-chairs: **Marco Siragusa, Verra Mobility & Morten Hother Sorensen, Arrive**

- Launched in September 2024 during the Annual General Assembly
- Continues EPA regulatory & technical campaigns on the topics of Cross-Border Enforcement (CBE) of parking infringements and the European Parking Card (EPC) for persons with disabilities

Communications Working Group

Chair: **Manuel Barrios, ASESGA**

- Launched in December 2025
- Develops EPA communications strategy for implementation in 2026-2027, possibly including a new [EPA website](#), new logo, (bi-)monthly [newsletter](#), revamped [PTI magazine](#), etc.

European Women in Parking ([E-WiP](#))

Co-chairs: **Yasmin Jefferies, BPA & Giovanna Piras, Automatic Systems**

- Aims to empower and connect women in the parking and mobility industry through mentorship, networking, and leadership development
- Promotes gender equity and inclusion across the sector
- Provides learning opportunities through webinars and events
- Celebrates women's achievements and supports talent attraction, retention, and career progression



EPA's Activities

Our campaigns

Cross-Border Enforcement (CBE) of parking infringements

- Regulatory campaign on the review of the EU CBE Directive (March 2023) with EU Affairs advisers Eurotran
- Assess additional EU-wide legal options / initiatives to ensure (digital) access to vehicle keeper/ holder data in support of free-flow parking
- Collaborate with other stakeholders such as POLIS and Eurocities

European Parking Card for persons with disabilities (EPC)

- Contributed to the EU Commission survey upon invitation by EY and partners (February 2023)
- Worked with Eurotran to ensure that the proposed legislation (September 2023) includes the concerns of EPA members
- Created "shadow expert group" to engage with EC on technical aspects
- Responded to EC consultation on (digital) security features of the physical card (April 2026)

Alliance for Parking Data Standards (APDS)

- Promote [APDS](#) as the global industry standard for parking data sharing, facilitating its uptake by all operators and suppliers
- Expand APDS applications with stakeholders such as EV Roaming Foundation (OCPI) and European Cycling Industries
- Assess opportunities for establishing a 'European Mobility Data Space' (EMDS) for parking

EPA Manifesto 2025-2030

- Produced an [EPA Manifesto](#) following the June 2024 EU elections, in consultation with EPA's membership, Board and Policy & Strategy Committee
- Established a forward-looking political "wish list" that sets out our vision for the sector over this five-year period
- Included 5 Policy Priorities to support clean, safe, resilient and intelligently managed urban mobility across Europe

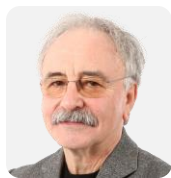

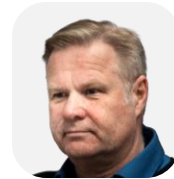

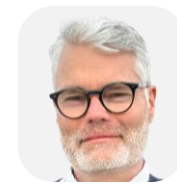
